



# Jingle All the Way

Easy-to-paint polka dots and stripes are used to create this festive project.  
Hang on the door and greet your guests with a cheery jingle!

## Essential Elements:

Jumbo Woodsies® Circles #01470: Three XXL (2 1/2")  
Woodsies® Circles #01382: Three Large (1 1/4")  
Hand Drill #02695

Loew-Cornell®: White Nylon Brush, Series 795-3 Round

## Palette:

DecoArt® Americana® Acrylic Paint:

Hauser Light Green    Cherry Red    Jack-o'-lantern Orange    Ultramarine Blue  
Optional: Snow White

## Additional Supplies:

Grosgrain Ribbon: 1 1/2 yds. of 1/8" wide, in coordinating style of choice. Sample uses Red with White stitching

Gold Jingle Bells: Seven small and five large

Black Permanent Felt Tip Marker

Craft Glue Dots®

## Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project. Refer to photo for placement.

*Note: Adult supervision is needed when using the hand drill.*

1. Paint large circles *Cherry Red*. Let dry. With marker on one circle, write "Jingle"; on second circle write "all the"; and on third circle write "Way!". *Hint: Design your own letters or use a computer font for inspiration.*
2. Drill two holes in each XXL Woodsies® circle, 1/4" from edge, directly across from one another.
3. Paint XXL circles as follows:  
Circle 1: Wiggly polka dots using *Hauser Light Green*, *Cherry Red*, and *Jack-o'-lantern Orange*.  
Circle 2: Wiggly stripes using *Hauser Light Green* and *Cherry Red*.  
Circle 3: Small polka dots using *Hauser Light Green*, *Cherry Red*, *Jack-o'-lantern Orange*, and *Ultramarine Blue*.  
*Optional:* Outline around all polka dots and stripes with *Snow White*.  
Let dry. Using two glue dots per circle, center and attach one Large circle to each XXL circle.  
*Tip: Depending if you want to display your garland vertically (as shown) or horizontally, will determine how you should align Large circles to display the wording.*
4. To form ribbon hanger, fold ribbon 4" from one end, thread one small jingle bell onto folded end of ribbon and tie an overhand knot enclosing loop of bell in knot.
5. Cut other end of ribbon at an angle for ease in threading through bells and circles. Thread large bell onto ribbon, slide bell until 2" from first bell and tie an overhand knot enclosing loop of bell in knot. Thread onto ribbon "Jingle" circle and slide circle until 2" from large bell. Refer to photo and continue threading bells and circles as desired.
6. Trim ribbon end at an angle.

*Tip: For ease in placing ribbon through hole in circles and jingle bells, unfold one end of paper clip and use point to help push ribbon through holes.*



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
