## Essential Elements:

- Loew-Cornell® **Totally You™**  
Black Apron with pocket - APGP-0303
- Two or more coordinating fabrics – one should have a focal point motif. (Fabric pieces are approximately 6" x 4" rough cut)
- 24" of coordinating trim
- Washable Fabric Glue or Iron-on Fusible Webbing
- Coordinating dimensional paint, or sewing machine & thread, for outlining edges of fabric



## Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project. Refer to photo for placement.

1. Layout fabric pieces in design of choice.  
*Options for securing fabric:*  
Use an old brush to spread a thin layer of fabric glue, or use an iron-on fusible webbing like Pellon Wonder Under®.
2. Finish edges of fabric with a fine zig zag stitch or outline with dimensional fabric paint.
3. Glue trim along top edge of apron and apron pocket.

## Essential Elements:

- **Loew-Cornell® Totally You™**  
White Apron with Pocket - APGP-0909
- **Loew-Cornell® Water Soluble Marker #723**  
(Optional)
- Coordinating Feather Boa, Rhinestones (about 30 depending on size), and Fabric Marker
- Dimensional Fabric Paint (Pearl or another light color) to use as glue
- Needle, Thread

## Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project. Refer to photo for placement.

1. Measure to find the horizontal center of the apron and write "Domestic Goddess" using fabric marker.
2. Add rhinestones at random using dimensional fabric paint as glue.
3. Sew feather boa to apron with long running stitches.

## Hints on Lettering:

- Measure and draw guidelines, then pre-draw letters using a water soluble marker or light pencil.
- Use computer fonts for inspiration, or print your words in desired font & size and use as a pattern.

## Essential Elements:

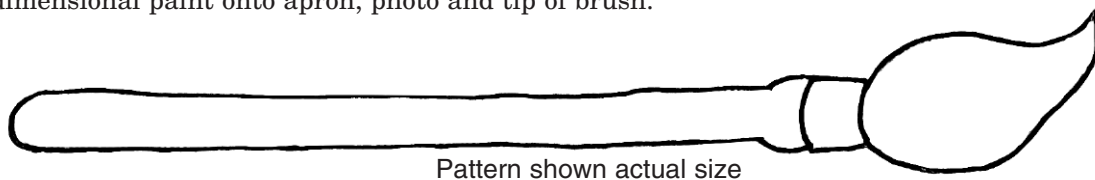
- Loew-Cornell® **Totally You™**  
Red Kid's Apron - KDAP-0202
- Loew-Cornell® White Nylon Brushes: 797F-2, Flat;  
797R-2, Round
- Loew-Cornell® Chacopaper #393 and Fabric Stylus #736
- Dimensional fabric paints in assorted colors
- Regular fabric paint: black, yellow, orange
- Iron-on Photo Paper
- Photo of your favorite artist



## Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project.  
Refer to photo for placement.

1. Print photo of your favorite artist onto iron-on photo paper and iron onto apron.
2. Transfer paintbrush pattern to apron using Chacopaper and stylus.
3. Paint paintbrush referring to photo for color placement. Shading on handle is done while black paint is still wet.
4. Add paint puddles of dimensional paint onto apron, photo and tip of brush.
