Materials List:

Loew-Cornell®

Compressed Sponges, #39
American Painter 4550-1, Wash brush
Water Soluble Marker, #723

Palette:

Tulip Soft Brushable Fabric Paint:

Velveteen White	Metallic Champagne
Azalea	Ebony
Holiday Green	Royal Blue
Sunshine Yellow	

Surface: Loew-Cornell Totally You!™ Adult Apron
Royal Blue, #APG-0101

Additional Supplies:

2 foam plates or another non-porous palette

Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project.
Use the photo and pattern as guides for placement.

For best results, pre-wash fabric and do not use fabric softener.

Measure down 9" from the top of the apron and mark with water soluble marker.

Trace and cut the sponges using the pattern pieces.
Wet to expand and then squeeze out excess water.

Using the fence sponge piece, press into the *Champagne* and tap off excess paint on a clean area of your palette.

Stamp the fence piece across the apron, positioning the bottom at your 9" mark. Reload the sponge after each impression.

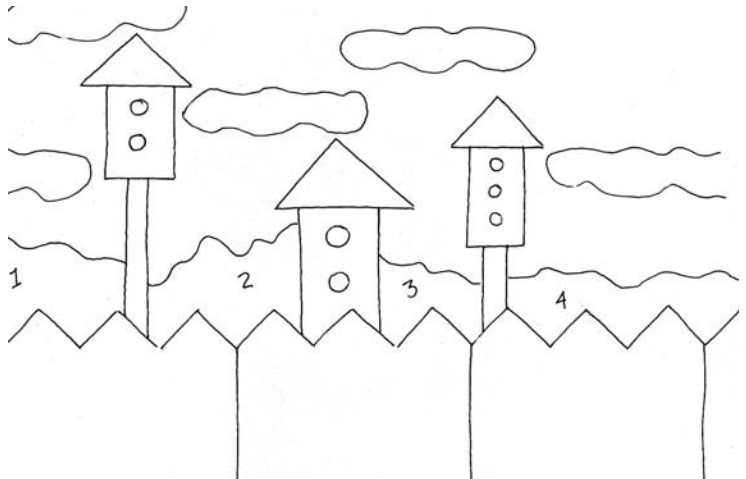
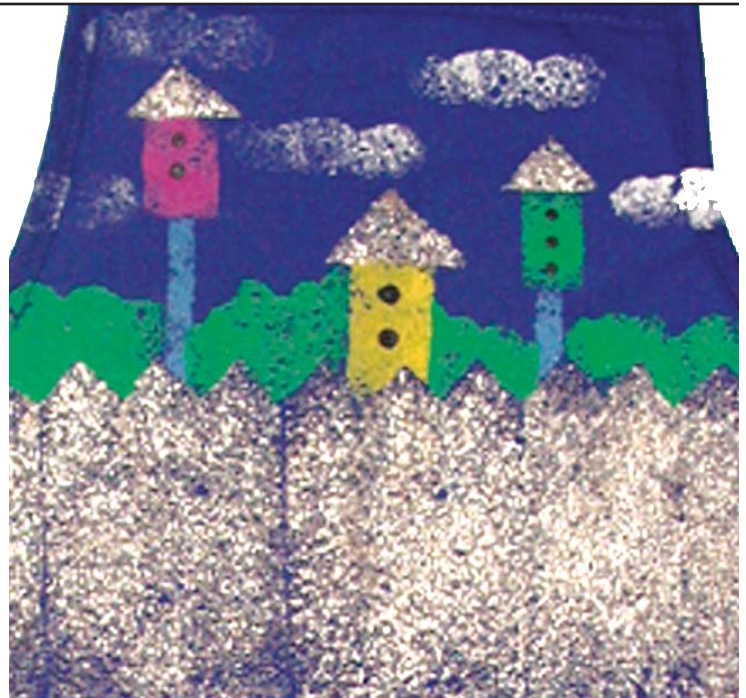
The rest of the design works up from the fence using the same techniques to load the sponges and stamp your impression.

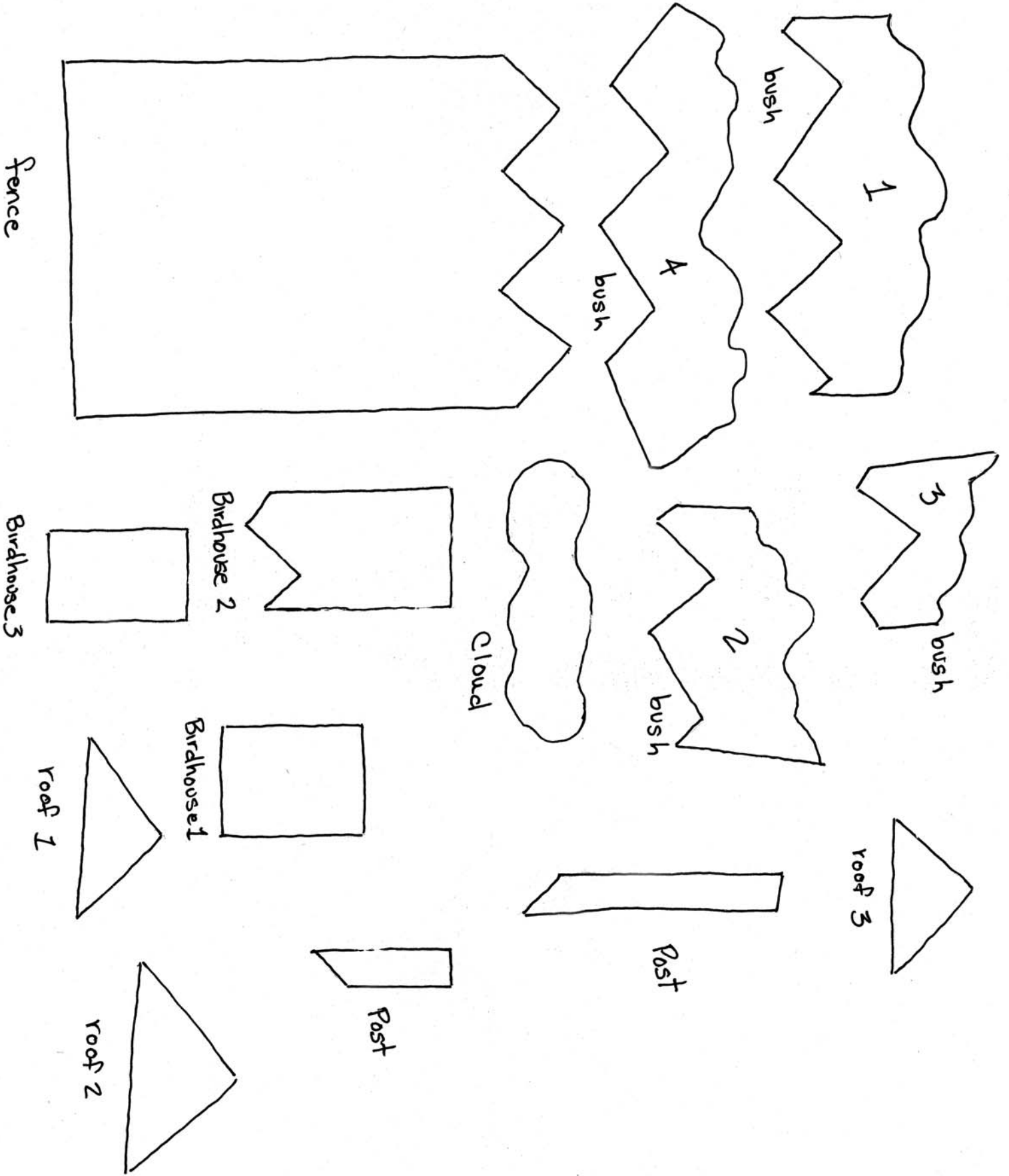
For best results work in suggested order and use photo and pattern as a guide for placement:

- Birdhouse Posts - *Royal Blue*
- Birdhouses - *Azalea, Holiday Green*
and *Sunshine Yellow*
- Birdhouse Roofs - *Champagne*
- Bushes - *Holiday Green*
- Clouds - *White*

Dip the end of the paintbrush handle in *Black* and make dots for the birdhouse hole openings.

Dry flat for 24 hours. Follow manufacturer's instructions for laundering.
