

Butterfly Tray

Materials List:

Loew-Cornell®

Compressed Sponges, #39
American Painter 4550-3/4", Wash brush
Fine sandpaper, #12345

Palette:

Delta Ceramcoat Acrylic Paint:
Jade Green Laguna Blue
Pretty Pink GP Purple
Purple Phthalo Green
Black

Surface:

Walnut Hollow #3580W Solid Wood Serving Tray

Additional Supplies:

Delta All Purpose Sealer
Tack cloth
2 Foam plates or another non-porous palette

Instructions:

Read all instructions before beginning your project. Use pattern and photo as a guide for placement.

Lightly sand tray and use tack cloth to remove fine particles.

Basecoat tray with 2 coats of *Jade Green*. Allow to dry, and sand lightly and tack between coats.

Trace and cut the sponges using the pattern pieces. Wet to expand and squeeze out excess water.

Using the large flower sponge piece, press into *Pretty Pink*, tap off excess paint onto a clean portion of your palette and add some *GP Purple* to the tips of a few of the flower petals using the wash brush. Press 3 flowers randomly around the tray reloading the sponge each time.

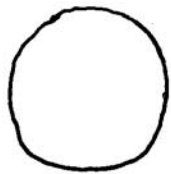
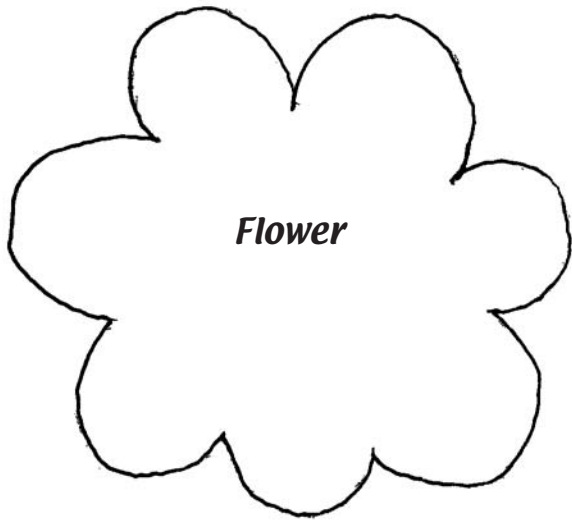
All other sponges are used in the same manner. For best results work in suggested order and use photo and pattern as a guide for placement:

- Large Round Sponge (Flower Center) - *Laguna Blue*. Tap off excess on a clean portion of the plate.
- Leaf Sponge - *Phthalo Green*. (Don't worry about overlapping onto the flowers.)
- Smaller Round Sponge - *GP Purple* on top of the *Laguna Blue* Flower Centers.

- Butterfly - *GP Purple*, 3 randomly placed
- Smaller Round Sponge - *Laguna Blue* dots on Butterflies
- Butterfly Body - *Black*
- Smaller Round Sponge - *Black* to make butterfly head

Allow to dry and then finish entire tray with 2-3 coats of Delta All Purpose Sealer.

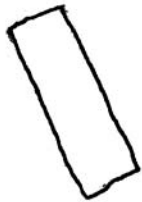
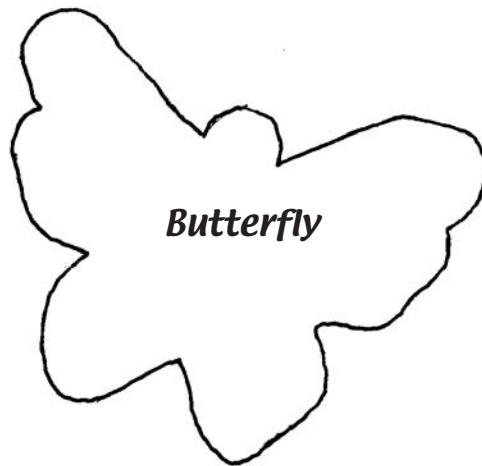




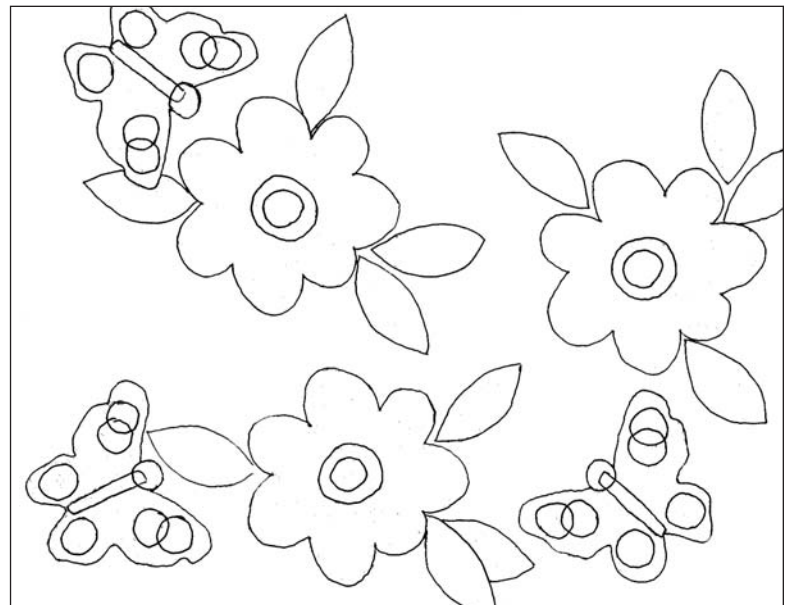
Large Flower Center
